**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS  
PLANNING/ZONING BOARD AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF A PLANNER  
FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR OF 2018**

WHEREAS, there exists in the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey, a need for planning services to be rendered to the Planning/Zoning Board of the Borough of Woodbury Heights; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.) authorizes the award of contracts for "professional services" without competitive bids; and

WHEREAS, the Planning/Zoning Board of the Borough of Woodbury Heights is an autonomous body and has the statutory authority to appoint an independent planner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 8<sup>th</sup> day of January 2018 that the Planning/Zoning Board of the Borough of Woodbury Heights hereby appoints Tiffany A. CuvIELLO, P.P., AICP as the Planner for the Borough of Woodbury Heights Planning/Zoning Board for the calendar year 2018, commencing January 1, 2018 and terminating December 31, 2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this contract shall be awarded without competitive bidding as "professional services" as authorized under the provisions of the Local Public Contract Law, because the person employed herein is licensed by law to practice as a recognized professional in the State of New Jersey.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Borough of Woodbury Heights Planning/Zoning Board and the Secretary of the Borough of Woodbury Heights Planning/Zoning Board, are hereby authorized to execute a contract between the Board and the Planner.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a notice of adoption of this Resolution shall be published in the South Jersey Times and/or the Courier Post, as required by law.
