

RESOLUTION 102-2020

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS WITH THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST DEPTFORD FOR CONSTRUCTION AND UCC CODE INSPECTION AND ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et. seq., permits municipalities and other local units to enter into Shared Services Agreements with other governmental units by adoption of a Resolution authorizing such shared services; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Borough of Woodbury Heights and West Deptford Township as the Provider to enter into a Shared Services Agreement for West Deptford to provide the Borough of Woodbury Heights with Construction Code and UCC Inspection and Enforcement Services pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough of Woodbury Heights Council recognize that by entering into a shared service agreement with West Deptford Township for such construction shared services, the particular details of which are set forth and memorialized in the Shared Services Agreement, are mutually beneficial to both municipalities; and

WHEREAS, such Agreements are encouraged by the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et. seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights that the Shared Service Agreement with West Deptford Township is hereby approved and authorized for execution by the appropriate Borough Officials, subject to the review and approval of such final agreement by the Borough Solicitor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution and Agreement shall be filed with the Commissioner of the Department of Community Affairs forthwith after the adoption hereof.


