RESOLUTION APPOINTING BOND COUNSEL  
FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2017

WHEREAS, there exists a need for the appointment of Bond Counsel to provide specialized services and advice for the calendar year of 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.) requires that a Resolution authorizing the award of contracts for "Professional Services" without competitive bids must be publicly advertised; and

WHEREAS, this appointment is made pursuant to an "Open and Fair" process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4, et seq.

WHEREAS, an invitation for Qualification Statements relating to this appointment was publicly advertised and proposals received and processed as a "fair and open process" as provided by N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4, et seq.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that **Parker McCay, P.A.** be and is hereby appointed as Bond Counsel retroactively commencing JANUARY 1, 2017 and ending on DECEMBER 31, 2017;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a "Professional Service" under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law because said Contract

encompasses a Professional service recognized, licensed and regulated by law;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be published in the South Jersey Times within ten (10) days of its adoption.
