

**RESOLUTION 39-2019**

**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR TRANSFERS OF 2018 APPROPRIATION RESERVES**

**WHEREAS**, there are certain 2018 Reserve Budget Appropriations of the Borough of Woodbury Heights with balances insufficient to meet the anticipated expenditures; and


**WHEREAS**, there is an excess in one or more of the 2018 Reserve Budget Appropriations over and above the amount deemed necessary to fulfill the purpose of such appropriations; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-59 provides for transfers from appropriation reserves with an excess over and above the amount deemed to be necessary to fulfill such purpose, to any appropriation reserve for the immediately preceding fiscal year deemed to be insufficient.


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey (not less than two-thirds of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring) that the following transfers are hereby authorized to be made by and between the 2018 Reserve Budget Appropriations:
