WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents, youth and other allies in efforts to prevent alcoholism and drug abuse in communities throughout New Jersey.

Dear Mayor Packer:

Gloucester County Division of Human & Disability Services has been notified by the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA) regarding a change to our original Fiscal Year 2021. This notification occurred as a result of a significant decline in the Drug Enforcement Demand Reduction (DEDR) Fund collections in Fiscal Year 2020. Specifically, a revised allocation for Fiscal Year 2021, per formula in the amount of \$80,862.00, will be distributed to municipalities. As you know, we are only permitted to contract with Municipal Alliances that attended the required GCADA trainings on the 'needs assessment and strategic planning' process. This funding announcement also remains contingent upon the availability of funds and is subject to the rules of the New Jersey Department of Treasury.

Because the Governor extended the state's budget Fiscal Year 2020 to September 30, 2020, this new grant period will begin October 1, 2020 and continue through June 30, 2021. **Borough of Woodbury Hts. allocation** for this timeframe is: **\$3,000 with a 25% cash match of \$ 750.00 and 75% in-kind match of \$2,250.** Mary Beth will send you a new Form 1-A and sample resolution which must be returned to her as soon as possible but no later than **August 24.** Mary Beth may be reached at 856-384-6887 or mbmonroe@co.gloucester.nj.us and remains available to you directly, should you need assistance with identifying plans and activities to support the mission of prevention education with this reduced funding allotment.

We understand how detrimental any decrease in funding can be to our programs and mission. Please know we are your partner during this unusual and challenging time and we will continue to work with you collaboratively to make a difference in the lives of the residents of this county.
