A RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATION WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY FEDERAL GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY, OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights wishes to apply for funding of approximately \$13,148.00 with a match of \$159,921.00 for an approximate project total cost of \$173,069.00 for a project under the State of New Jersey Safe and Secure Communities Grant Program under grant number 22-0823 covering the period of 10/1/21 to 9/30/22, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights has reviewed the accompanying application and has approved said request, and

WHEREAS, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety and the Borough of Woodbury Heights for the purpose described in the application;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council that:

1. As a matter of public policy Borough of Woodbury Heights wishes to participate to the fullest extent possible with the Department of Law and Public Safety.
2. The Attorney General will receive funds on behalf of the applicant.
3. The Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of the Attorney General shall be responsible for the receipt and review of the applications for said funds.
4. The Department of Law and Public Safety, Office of the Attorney General shall initiate allocations to each applicant as authorized.
