## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENT BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS WITH LOGAN TOWNSHIP FOR SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION AND MARKETING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et. seq., permits municipalities and other local units to enter into Shared Services Agreements with other governmental units by adoption of a Resolution authorizing such shared services; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Height and the Township of Logan (hereinafter "Logan") to enter into a Shared Services Agreement for solid waste & recycling collection and marketing services pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights recognize that by entering into a shared service agreement with Logan for such trash and recycling collection and marketing services, the particular details of which are set forth and memorialized in the attached Shared Services Agreement, are mutually beneficial to both entities; and

WHEREAS, such Agreements are encouraged by the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et. seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights that the attached Shared Service Agreement with Logan Township is hereby approved and authorized for execution by the appropriate Borough Officials for solid waste and recycling collection and marketing services, subject to the final review and approval of such agreement by the Township Solicitor.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that a copy of this Resolution and Agreement shall be filed with the Commissioner of the Department of Community Affairs forthwith after the adoption hereof.
