

RESOLUTION 35-2022

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING SALARY ADJUSTMENT AND BENEFITS FOR THE BOROUGH POLICE CHIEF

WHEREAS, the Borough's Police Chief, has been employed by the Borough of Woodbury Heights for approximately seventeen (17) years; serving as Acting Chief from September 2017 through June 2018, at which time he was appointed Chief of the Borough of Woodbury Heights Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the experience and knowledge of the Police Chief has enabled Chief Moline to lead the Woodbury Heights Police Department to provide outstanding services to the residents of Woodbury Heights; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's Public Safety Committee has determined that a salary adjustment is warranted and appropriate for the Borough Police Chief retroactive to January 1, 2022, which adjustment is within the range approved in the 2022 Salary Ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, that the Public Safety Committee recommendation to Borough Council for the salary adjustment of the Police Chief in the amount of \$119,250.00, retroactive to January 1, 2022 is hereby authorized and approved effective immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Police Chief shall be entitled to the following benefits afforded to the Members of the Woodbury Heights Police Association PBA Local 122, as recited in the most recent contract effective January 1, 2020:

1. Article IX :“Legal Aid”
2. Article X : “Dues Deduction”
3. Article XI: Pension
4. Article XV: Personal Days (all days to be calculated at 8 hours)
5. Article XVI: Sick Leaves and Leaves of Absence (all days to be calculated at 8 hours)
6. Article XVII: Vacations (all days to be calculated at 8 hours)
7. Article XIX: Insurance/Medical
8. Article XX: Clothing
9. Article XXII: Incentives


