

RESOLUTION 44- 2022

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS AND THE BOROUGH OF WENONAH REGARDING THE STORAGE AND USE OF THE JET/VAC SEWER CLEANER

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wenonah (“Wenonah”) and the Borough of Woodbury Heights (“Woodbury Heights”) determined it is in their mutual best interests to enter into a Shared Services Agreement (“Agreement”), wherein Woodbury Heights is willing to provide up to five (5) sewer cleaning services per month to the Borough of Wenonah in exchange for Wenonah providing a secure storage facility for the Borough of Woodbury Heights’ 2021 Freightliner Jet/Vac Sewer cleaner, Vin number 1FVAG 5FE8M HML22 03; and

WHEREAS, said Shared Services Agreement is established in accordance with the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, P.L. 2007, c.63 (C:40A:65-1, et seq.), N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, said Shared Services Agreement was executed by and between the parties and is further incorporated herein by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, that the Borough herein authorizes the execution of a revised Shared Services Agreement between the Borough of Woodbury Heights and the Borough of Wenonah to have Wenonah provide secure storage of the Jet/Vac Sewer Cleaner under the terms set forth in the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, and take any other necessary action to effectuate the purposes of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a true copy of each adopted Resolution, as well as the executed Shared Services Agreement be forwarded and filed by the Clerk directly with the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs.
