

RESOLUTION 63 - 2022

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE GLOUCESTER COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE PROGRAM YEAR 2022

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights intends to submit a proposal to the County of Gloucester for a Community Development Block Grant for a project attributable to fiscal year 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights intends to apply for funds to reconstruct the curb cuts at the intersection of Vanderbilt Avenue and Hamilton Road AND Vanderbilt Avenue and Clemson Road to provide barrier free access; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is satisfied that the scope of the project as funded by the Community Development Block Grant Program will benefit all residents of the Borough of Woodbury Heights and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Borough understands and accepts that grant funds may not be available to defray all of the project costs and the Borough will be required to contribute funds in furtherance of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that an Application to the County of Gloucester for a Community Development Block Grant for fiscal year 2022, for the aforesaid project, is hereby authorized and that the Borough Chief Municipal Finance Officer is designated as the authorized person to act on behalf of the Borough in connection therewith.
