AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$ 86,000.00 TO BE USED FOR VANDERBILT AVENUE/MOORE STREET AND MOORE STREET/TEMPLE AVENUE BARRIER FREE SIDEWALKS AND RAMPS IN THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to complete barrier free sidewalks and ramps at the intersection of Vanderbilt Avenue & Moore Street and at Moore Street and Temple Avenue; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available for said purpose from the Community Development Block Grant and capital improvement fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, that:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated from the following sources the sum of \$86,000.00 to be used for the following capital project within the Borough of Woodbury Heights:

SECTION 2: In connection with the amounts authorized in Section 1, the Borough makes the following determinations:

- a) The purpose described in Section 1 is not a Current Expense and is an improvement, which the Borough may lawfully make as a general improvement.
- b) The period of usefulness of the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof is five (5) years or more.
- c) No debt is authorized by this ordinance.
- d) The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and available for inspection

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances that are inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage, publication in accordance with law and after final adoption as provided by law.
