A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING TAXES FOR DISABLED VETERAN AND REFUNDING OVERPAYMENT

WHEREAS, the Borough received a notification that the Gloucester County Office of Assessment has qualified the owner who owns fifty percent (50%) of block 68, lot 11, a/k/a 747 Glassboro Road as exempt for real estate taxation pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, et seq by reason of military service total disability determination; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid exemption has been determined to be effective as of November 4, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that the property known as block 68, lot 11 and also known as 747 Glassboro Road is hereby determined as fifty percent (50%) exempt from taxation during its ownership and occupancy by the present disabled veteran owner effective November 4, 2020.

BE IT FURTHER RSOLVED that the property record will be bifurcated by the Gloucester County Tax Assessor for 2023 to allow for a full exemption on block 68, lot 11 qualified X, which will be assigned 50% of the assessed value of the property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is authorized to refund the following amounts:
