A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, STATE OF NEW JERSEY ELIMINATING HEALTH INSURANCEWAIVER PAYMENTS TO EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 52:14-17.31a and 40A:10-17.1 authorize local units providing employee health benefits through the State Health Benefits Program (SHBP) or non-SHBP coverage, respectively, to make annual payments to employees in exchange for waiving health coverage proved by the local unit; and

WHEREAS, Woodbury Heights has offered said waiver to its employees within the confines of the authorization in the past; and

WHEREAS, Woodbury Heights currently does not have any employees participating in the waiver program; and

WHEREAS, Woodbury Heights has reviewed said policy as per LFN 2016-10 and has found that waivers should no longer be offered due to the substantial increase in Health Insurance Premiums coupled with the cost share of said premiums established by Chapter 78.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that waiver payments for employees waiving health insurance coverage from the Borough of Woodbury Heights will no longer be offered by the Borough.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
