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Introduction

Consulting Engineer Services (CES) has prepared this Recycling Report for the proposed commercial development located on Block 40, Lots 3 & 11.01 of Woodbury Heights Borough, Gloucester County, New Jersey (hereinafter the “Site”). The approximate 0.50± acre Site is located within the Borough’s Highway Commercial (HC) Zoning District. The applicant proposes to convert the existing bank building with a use as a Class 5 cannabis retail facility.

The Site is situated along the southerly line of Elm Avenue, a short distance east of Mantua Pike (NJSH Route 45), in Woodbury Heights Borough, NJ. To the immediate east of the Site is an office building which appears to be vacant. Directly to the north, on the opposite side of Elm Avenue is a vacant land, and a residential dwelling to the northeast. The Site has frontage along Elm Avenue.

Materials To be Collected and Frequency

A. General Consumer Recyclables

The anticipated recyclables include the following:

<u>Materials</u>	<u>Pick-Up Frequency</u>
Cardboard/Paper	Once Weekly
Plastic	Once Weekly
Aluminum	Once Weekly
Glass	Once Weekly

Recyclables will be collected and stored in suitable containers located in the trash/recycling enclosure.

B. General Refuse

General refuse will be collected and stored in suitable containers located in the trash/recycling enclosure. General refuse will be collected once weekly.

Cannabis Waste

All cannabis waste items including usable cannabis, components, or materials that have been confirmed to be contaminated, but not limited to usable cannabis that fails testing or is returned as part of a recall, will be collected and stored in a secure waste receptacle until destroyed and rendered unusable. Green Cycler Composter (or equivalent product) will be utilized to render cannabis unusable, which is a small appliance that chops up compostable items into an odor-free container.

After destroying and rendering the cannabis waste unusable, the compostable waste will be placed into a biodegradable bag and non-compostable waste into a regular trash bag. These bags will be stored in the secure waste receptacle until disposal. Cannabis waste will be collected once weekly.

Location of Materials to Be Stored



All general consumer recyclable materials collected by the owner will first be separated from the other trash. The recyclable material will then be stored within the trash/recycling enclosure located on Site. The general consumer recyclables will remain in the trash/recycling enclosure area until they are due for pick up. All cannabis waste will be stored in locking receptacles in the designated area.

Responsible Waste Hauler

The owner of the project will have ultimate responsibility for pick up and disposal of all trash and recyclable materials. The owner will also have the responsibility for contracting with a permitted waste company to pick up the cannabis waste for transport to a compost, anaerobic facility, landfill, or incinerator, as applicable. All trash and recyclable materials will be disposed of by appropriately licensed waste haulers. All the cannabis waste will be disposed of by appropriately licensed waste company.
