

RESOLUTION 41 -2023
A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING TAXES FOR
DISABLED VETERAN AND REFUNDING OVERPAYMENT

WHEREAS, the Borough received a notification that the Gloucester County Office of Assessment has qualified the owner of block 92, lot 10, a/k/a 767 Woodland Avenue as exempt for real estate taxation pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30, et seq by reason of military service total disability determination; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid exemption has been determined to be effective as of December 8, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor concurring, that the property known as block 92, lot 10 and also known as 767 Woodland Avenue is hereby determined as exempt from taxation during its ownership and occupancy by the present disabled veteran owner effective December 8, 2022.
