ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY CANCELING CERTAIN FUNDED APPROPRIATION BALANCES HERETOFORE PROVIDED FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND REAPPROPRIATING SUCH FUNDED APPROPRIATION BALANCES FOR OTHER CAPITAL PROJECTS

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, New Jersey ("Borough"), duly and finally adopted Bond Ordinances 07-2019 and 10-2019 (collectively, the "Bond Ordinances"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough, having completed the projects authorized under the Bond Ordinances, has remaining funded balances in an aggregate total amount of \$196,278.51;

WHEREAS, the Borough is desirous of canceling and reappropriating such funded balances for the acquisition of various pieces of capital equipment and the completion of various capital improvements in and for the Borough as set forth herein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER, NEW JERSEY (NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF ALL THE MEMBERS THEREOF AFFIRMATIVELY CONCURRING), PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL BOND LAW, CHAPTER 169 OF THE LAWS OF 1960 OF THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED ("LOCAL BOND LAW"), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following appropriations remaining as a balance in the following Bond Ordinances heretofore adopted by the Borough, are hereby cancelled:

Section 2. The sum of \$196,278.51, which represents the funded appropriations cancelled in Section 1 hereof, is hereby reappropriated from the Bond Ordinances for various improvements to the Borough's water and sewer utility system including, but not limited to, supplemental funding for the replacement of the Candidus Avenue Sanitary Sewer Pump Station,

together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefore or related thereto (collectively, the "Improvements").

Section 3. The period of usefulness of the Improvements, within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof, is not less than forty (40) years.

<u>Section 4.</u> The Capital Budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended Capital Budget and Capital Program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and available for inspection.

<u>Section 5.</u> The Improvements authorized hereby are not current expenses and are general improvements that the Borough may lawfully make. No part of the cost of the Improvements authorized hereby has been or shall be specially assessed on any property specially benefited thereby.

Section 6. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

<u>Section 7.</u> This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final passage.
