RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS AUTHORIZING SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF WOODBURY FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND POLICE PROTECTION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights and the City of Woodbury heretofore entered into a Temporary Shared Services Agreement regarding Police Department services; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et. seq. ("Shared Services Law"), specifically authorizes local government units, including counties and municipalities, to enter into Shared Services Agreements; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Borough of Woodbury Heights and the City of Woodbury to enter into a long-term Shared Services Agreement for full time police protection and law enforcement services pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-4 and 8; and

WHEREAS, such agreements are encouraged by the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et. seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, and State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. That the Borough Council does hereby approve and authorize the execution of the attached Shared Services Agreement with the City of Woodbury for police protection and law enforcement services to commence July 21, 2023.
- 2. That the Mayor and Borough Officials be and are hereby authorized to execute the Shared Service Agreement on behalf of the Borough of Woodbury Heights.

3. That the aforementioned Agreement be and is hereby subject to final review and approval by the Borough Solicitor.
