

RESOLUTION 116-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS AND THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST DEPTFORD FOR A CERTIFIED RECYCLING PROFESSIONAL TO PREPARE THE ANNUAL RECYCLING TONNAGE REPORT AND FOR USE OF WEST DEPTFORD'S BUCKET TRUCK AND CHIPPER BY THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS

WHEREAS, beginning in 2012, each New Jersey municipality is required by the Recycling Enhancement Act (REA) to have mandatory Annual Recycling Tonnage Reports approved and "signed" by a Certified Recycling Professional (hereinafter "CRP"). Recycling Tonnage Reports will be submitted via email to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) utilizing a spreadsheet compatible with the Microsoft Excel structure provided by the department; and

WHEREAS, Woodbury Heights is a Municipal Corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal offices located at 500 Elm Avenue, Woodbury Heights, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, West Deptford is a Municipal Corporation of the State of New Jersey, with its principal offices located at 400 Crown Point Road, West Deptford, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights and the Township of West Deptford executed a Shared Services Agreement commencing on December 21, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides for the option to renew for two (2) additional one-year-terms; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights and the Township of West Deptford wish to renew the Agreement for an additional one (1) year term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, with the Mayor Concurring, that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are herein authorized to execute the renewal of said Agreement by and between the Borough of Woodbury Heights and the Township of West Deptford for the use of a CRP to complete and submit the West




