

RESOLUTION 42- 2025

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THE SERVICE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF WOODBURY HEIGHTS AND THE GLOUCESTER COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY (GCUA)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Sewage Authorities Law, Chapter 384 of the Pamphlet Laws of 1957 of the State of New Jersey effective February 10, 1978, the Gloucester County Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as "GCUA"), was reorganized by virtue of a Resolution duly adopted by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Gloucester, New Jersey and is a public body politic and corporate of the State of New Jersey, organized and existing under said Law, established as an instrumentality exercising public and essential governmental functions to provide for the public health and welfare, with all necessary or proper powers to acquire, construct, maintain, operate and use sanitation facilities for the relief of the Delaware River and its tributaries and other waters in, bordering and entering the Townships from pollution or threatened pollution and for improvement of conditions affecting the public health; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodbury Heights ("the Borough") constructed various sewage collection and conveyance systems to serve the defined service area of the Borough, but cannot treat said sewage, the Borough is required to deliver said sewage to the GCUA's facilities for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the GCUA agreed to accept the Borough sewage and other wastes originating within the defined service area into its wastewater treatment facility for final treatment and disposal; and

WHEREAS, the Borough and GCUA entered into an initial Service Agreement as outlined in the Borough's Resolution R-65-74 dated November 11, 1974; and the GCUA Resolution dated January 7, 1975; and

WHEREAS, the GCUA, at the direction of NJDEP, is required to provide updated Service Agreements with all municipalities in the County; and

WHEREAS, the attached Service Agreement outlines the responsibilities of both parties and establishes that the Borough shall have no limit on the volume of sewage and other waste delivered into the GCUA.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. That the Borough of Woodbury Heights does hereby approve and authorize the execution of the attached Service Agreement with the Gloucester County Utilities Authority.

2. That the Mayor and the Public Works Director are hereby authorized to execute said Agreement on behalf of the Borough of Woodbury Heights.
