

RESOLUTION 59-2025

GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER (GCSUD) ALLIANCE TO PREVENT SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Substance Use Disorder (GCSUD) established the Municipal Alliances for the Prevention of Substance Use Disorder in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents, youth and other allies in efforts to prevent substance use disorder in communities throughout New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey recognizes that substance use disorder is a serious problem in society amongst people of all ages and therefore has established a Municipal Alliance Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council further recognizes that it is incumbent upon not only public officials but the entire community to take action to prevent substance use disorder in our community; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has applied for funding to the Governor's Council on Substance Use Disorder through the County of Gloucester.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights, County of Gloucester, State of New Jersey the following is hereby recognized:

1. The Borough Council does hereby authorize submission of a strategic plan for the Woodbury Heights Municipal Alliance grant for the fiscal year 2026 in the amount of:

GCSUD Grant:	\$ 4,000.00
Cash Match:	\$ 1,000.00
In-Kind:	\$ 3,000.00

2. The Borough Council acknowledges the terms and conditions for administering the Municipal Alliance grant, including the administrative compliance and auditing requirements.


