RESOLUTION 93-2024

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING, ESTABLISHING AND APPROVING CLEAN COMMUNITIES "ADOPT-A-DRAIN" PROGRAM

WHEREAS, storm drains do not flow to sewage treatment plants, but rather discharge directly to bodies of water; and

WHEREAS, storm drains also do not remove pollutants from stormwater and were designed for the specific purpose of draining water from sidewalks and streets to prevent local flooding; and

WHEREAS, the Borough recognizes that "clogged" storm drains cause longterm damage to pipes due to the accumulation of waste, which could also lead to flooding and the recognition that the "waste" that flows through to our rivers, lakes and oceans can kill or injure fish, vegetation and other wildlife and can further contaminate the drinking water supply of residents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council desire to authorize, establish and approve the clean communities "Adopt-A-Drain" program that seeks volunteers within the community to keep and maintain storm drains that will lead to clean storm drains free of leaves, debris, and litter for a cleaner community and safer drinking water.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Woodbury Heights that the Borough Council does hereby authorize, establish and approve the Borough of Woodbury Heights Clean Communities "Adopt-A-Drain" program that shall be overseen and implemented by Jolyn Gregoria, forthwith after the adoption hereof.
